SUBJECT: Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)

In view of the recent actions by the Federal Government concerning DACA immigrants, I along with the Director and members of the Legal Unit have reviewed US Citizenship & Immigration Services (USCIS) documents and have determined that the Department will allow, on a trial basis, the DACA immigrants to apply and test for a driver license or ID card.

DACA applicants must meet all requirements of 760-X-1-.20, Alabama Administrative Code (Authorized Presence) with the exception of having an I-94 form accompanying their passport. They should have the following:

- Current passport
- 797 showing deferred action request (copy is attached)
- Employment Authorization Card with a C33 Code
- Social Security card

In order for the Department of Public Safety to maintain an accurate and secure database, please direct any questions or concerns about the documents presented by an applicant to a sworn trooper who has been ICE trained prior to processing the applicant.
